Livelihood Support Projects

There are livelihood support projects that aim to ensure a steady supply of fresh fish by providing transportation means to fishermen or fish vendors. The plan includes the distribution of 200 two-wheelers with built-in ice boxes, 50 auto rickshaws with ice boxes, and 15 insulated trucks with capacities of 3 and 6 tons. These vehicles will likely be used to transport fish from the point of catch or storage to market or distribution centers, helping to keep the fish fresh and increasing the reach of the fishermen or vendors.
