

Chethy Fishing Village

(Mararikulam North Grama Panchayat - Kanjikuzhy Block)

A Brief Profile of the Chethyi Fishing Village

Chethy fisheries village is spread over five wards of Mararikulam North Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 9, 11, 15, 16 and 17. The village has a total of 992 houses and 1048 households are living there. Among them, 63 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 41.33 percent houses are pucca, 44.86 percent are semi-pucca and 13.81 percent houses are kachha houses. About 87.80 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 90.02 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (95.87 %) are electrified. It is noted that 264 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 18 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 7 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has two sub centres. The village has one LP School and one high school. Ten anganawadis are functioning in this village and only two of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 8 roads of 4.05 Km length. The village has 42 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 197 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 97 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre. The village has one ice plant and two markets. The village has a protected coastal length of 1.00 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
