

## **Thaikkal Fishing Village**

(Cherthala South GP - Kanjikuzhy Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Thaikkal Fishing Village***

Taikkal fisheries village is spread over four wards of Cherthala South Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 19, 20 and 21. The village has a total of 1280 houses and 1312 households are living there. Among them, 40 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 37.89 percent houses are pucca, 51.95 percent are semi-pucca and 10.16 percent houses are kachha houses. About 85.16 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 75 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.89 %) are electrified. It is noted that 331 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 9 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 5 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub centre and one homoeo hospital. The village has one UP School. Eight anganawadis are functioning in this village and seven of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 13 roads of 16.15 Km length. The village has 10 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 100 country fishing boats and 15 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 53 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre. The village has coastal line of 4.00 Km, out of which 1.50 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
