A Brief Profile of the Ayyampilli Fishing Villages

Ayyampilli fisheries village is located in ward 1 of Kuzhuppilli Gram Panchayat. The village has a total of 240 houses and 260 households are living there. Among them, 20 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 8.33 percent houses are pucca, 75 percent are semi-pucca and 16.67 percent houses are kachha houses. About 93.75 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 85 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (96.67 %) are electrified. It is noted that 142 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 19 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 8 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub-centre. The village has three LP schools. Two anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 2 roads of length 4 Km. The village has 12 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 20 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 58 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one market. The village has a protected coastal length of 1.55 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
