

## **Kandakkadavu Fishing Village**

(Chellanam G P - Palluruthy Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Kandakkadavu Fishing Villages***

Kandakkadavu fisheries village is located in ward 10 of Chellanam Gram Panchayat. The village has a total of 340 houses and 368 households are living there. Among them, 28 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 52.06 percent houses are pucca, 31.47 percent are semi-pucca and 16.47 percent houses are kachha houses. About 83.53 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 85.88 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (88.24 %) are electrified. It is noted that 142 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 18 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 9 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one PHC and one ayurveda hospital. The village has one Higher Secondary School. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and four of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 7 roads of length 6.80 Km and 5 Km drainage. The village has 25 street lights and only five of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 157 country fishing boats and 4 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 114 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one market. The village has a protected coastal length of 3.60 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and financial requirements are presented in Tables 6 and 7.
