

## **Thayyil Fishing Village**

### **(Kannur Municipality)**

#### ***Profile of Thayyil Fishing village***

This fisheries village is spread over two wards of Kannur Municipality. The coastal wards of this village are 29 and 30. The village has a total of 719 houses and 747 households are living there. Among them, 35 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 51.88 percent houses are pucca, 37.83 percent are semi-pucca and 10.29 percent houses are kachha houses. Less than half of the existing houses (53.69 %) in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 96.80 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (94.85 %) are electrified. It is noted that 1150 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 61 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 37 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one homoeo hospital, three UP Schools and one High school. Eight anganawadis are functioning, out of which four of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 6 roads of length 5.200 km. The village has 200 street lights and all of them are not functional. It is noted that 256 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 101 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has two private ice plants and one market. The village has an unprotected coastal length of 3.5 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and financial requirements are presented in Tables 24 and 25.
