

# **Sakthikulangara Fishing Village**

(Kollam Corporation)

## ***A Brief Profile of the Sakthikulangara Fishing Village***

Sakthikulangara fisheries village is spread over three wards of Kollam Corporation. The coastal wards of this village are 1,2 and 3. The village has a total of 1620 houses and 1627 households are living there. Among them, 10 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 45.12 percent houses are pucca, 53.58 percent are semi-pucca and 1.30 percent houses are kachha houses. About 97.41 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 93.70 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.78%) are electrified. It is noted that 342 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 16 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 7 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one PHC and one sub centre. The village has two LP Schools, one UP School and one High School. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and three of them are functioning in own buildings. This village has a network of 9 roads of 8.100 Km length and 2.10 Km drainage. The village has 204 street lights and 200 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 255 country fishing boats and 204 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 178 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre. The village has 14 ice plants and one market. The village has coastal line of 3.750 Km, out of which 3 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
