(Kozhikode Corporation)

A Brief Profile of the Pallikandy Fishing Village

Pallikandy fisheries village is located at ward no 33 of Kozhikodu Corporation. The village has a total of 400 houses and 467 households are living there. Among them, 73 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 35 percent houses are pucca, 53.75 percent are semi-pucca and 11.25 percent houses are kachha houses. About 94.50 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 77.75 percent of the existing houses. Less than three fourth of the houses in the village (70 %) are electrified. It is noted that 197 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 9 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 2 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub-centre. The village has one LP School. Twenty anganawadis are functioning in this village and 16 of them are functioning in rented buildings. This village has a network of 8 roads of length 29.77 Km, 0.50 Km drainage and four culverts. The village has 50 street lights and 40 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 95 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 46 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish market. The village has a coastal length of 0.40 Km, out of which 0.15 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
