

Drainage Facilities

The Department of Fisheries has undertaken significant interventions to improve drainage facilities across the coastal stretch, addressing long-standing issues of waterlogging and poor sanitation. The initiatives include the construction of new drainage networks, renovation and desilting of existing drains, and installation of proper outlets to ensure smooth discharge of stormwater and waste. These measures have greatly reduced flooding in low-lying fishing villages, improved public hygiene, and enhanced the overall living conditions in coastal areas, thereby supporting the sustainable development of coastal communities.
