

Women Shelter Shed

A Women's Shelter Shed provides a much-needed resting space for fisherwomen who are actively involved in the collection, sorting, and marketing of fish harvests. Often, these women begin their work in the early hours of the morning and continue late into the day, enduring harsh weather conditions and long working hours along the coast or fish landing areas. The shelter sheds offer them a safe and comfortable spaces to rest, refresh, and temporarily store their belongings during these odd hours.

Recognizing the vital role of fisherwomen in the fisheries value chain, the Government has initiated the construction of women's shelter sheds at key fish landing and marketing centres. These facilities serve as a symbol of empowerment and welfare, ensuring dignity, safety, and better working conditions for women engaged in fisheries-related activities.
