

Aryankadappuram Fishing Village

(Parappanangadi GP-Thiroorangadi Block)

A Brief Profile of the Aryankadappuram Fishing Village

Aryankadappuram fisheries village is spread over three wards of Parappangadi Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 19, 21 and 22. The village has a total of 1285 houses and 1338 households are living there. Among them, 65 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 22.57 percent houses are pucca, 66.15 percent are semi-pucca and 11.28 percent houses are kachha houses. About 90.66 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 95.33 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (87.55 %) are electrified. It is noted that 457 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 58 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 17 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one sub-centre. The village has two LP schools. Eleven anganawadis are functioning in this village and six of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 9 roads of 11.30 km length, 6 km drainage and 6 culverts. The village has 92 street lights and only 41 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 80 country fishing boats and 18 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 79 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one fish landing centre and one guide light. The village has one fish market and four ice plants. The village has coastal line of 3 Km and out which 2 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
