## Veliyancodu Fishing Village

(Veliyancodu Grama Panchayat - Perumpadappu Block)

## A Brief Profile of the Veliyancodu Fishing Village

Veliyancodu fisheries village is spread over four wards of Veliyancodu Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 14, 16 and 17. The village has a total of 790 houses and 870 households are living there. Among them, 80 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 43.67 percent houses are pucca, 36.71 percent are semi-pucca and 19.62 percent houses are kachha houses. About 77.85 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 76.58 percent of the existing houses. Less than three fourth of the houses in the village (72.78 %) are electrified. It is noted that 325 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 49 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 15 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one hospital and one homoeo hospital. The village has two LP schools. Fifteen anganawadis are functioning in this village and eight of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 8 roads of 15.900 km length, 7 Km drainage and 15 culverts. The village has 14 street lights and only 5 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 5 country fishing boats and 2 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 7 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant. The village has coastal line of 5.30 Km and out which 3.00 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.

The results of situation analysis and needs and requirements are presented in Tables 4 and 5 while the financial requirements are given in Table 6.
