

## Engandiyoor Fishing Village

(Engandiyoor Grama Panchayat - Thalikulam Block)

### ***A Brief Profile of the Engandiyoor Fishing Villages***

Engandiyoor fisheries village is spread over three wards of Engandiyoor Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 11, 13 and 15. The village has a total of 1150 houses and 1157 households are living there. Among them, 9 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 54.43 percent houses are pucca, 38.27 percent are semi-pucca and 7.30 percent houses are kachha houses. About 99.74 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 84.35 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (99.13 %) are electrified. It is noted that 445 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 68 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 13 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one Sub-centre. The village has one UP School and two High Schools. Six anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 12 roads of 13.75 km length. The village has 150 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 113 country fishing boats and 7 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 97 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has three ice plants. The village has coastal line of 2.70 Km and out which 1 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
