

## Manthalamkunnu Fishing Village

(Punnayoorkulam Grama Panchayat - Chavakkadu Block)

### **A Brief Profile of the Manthalamkunnu Fishing Villages**

Manthalamkunnu fisheries village is spread over five wards of Punnayoorkulam Gram Panchayat. The coastal wards of this village are 1, 15, 16, 17 and 18. The village has a total of 1520 houses and 1589 households are living there. Among them, 80 are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 53.29 percent houses are pucca, 39.14 percent are semi-pucca and 7.57 percent houses are kachha houses. About 87.17 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 80.66 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (97.76 %) are electrified. It is noted that 436 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 51 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 11 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one PHC. The village has two LP Schools, one UP School and one Higher Secondary School. Seven anganawadis are functioning in this village and five of them are functioning in its own building. This village has 16 roads of 12.70 km length. The village has 50 street lights and all of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 60 country fishing boats and 2 mechanized boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 42 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one landing centre. The village has an unprotected coastal line of 2.315 Km. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are moderate in this village.
