

Beemapally Fishing Village

(Thiruvananthapuram Corporation)

Brief Profile of Beemapally fishing village

Beemapally fisheries village is spread over ward 78 and half portion of ward 77 of Thiruvananthapuram Corporation. The village has a total of 1870 houses and 2118 households are living there. Among them, 296 households are landless or presently living as a joint family. Regarding the housing situation in the village, it is noted that 74.22 percent houses are pucca, 19.36 percent are semi-pucca and 6.42 percent houses are kachha houses. About 90.80 percent of the existing houses in the village have sanitary toilets. Safe drinking water is available to 89.47 percent of the existing houses. Most of the houses in the village (98.77 %) are electrified. It is noted that 1020 persons from the fisher folk community are insured with the Fisheries Board (Matsya Board). And 68 persons are covered under the old age pension scheme and 22 persons are covered under widow pension scheme during 2007-08 in this village.

Regarding the community specific facilities, this village has one homoeo hospital. The village has two LP Schools and two UP Schools. Eleven anganawadis are functioning in this village and all of them are functioning in rented building. This village has a network of 11 roads of length 6.15 Km. The village has 64 street lights and 30 of them are functional. About the fisheries specific infrastructure and facilities, it is noted that 30 country fishing boats are available in this fisheries village. And a total of 42 kerosene permits are issued to the fisher folk in this. The village has one ice plant. The village has a coastal length of 1Km, out of which 0.50 Km is protected. Consumption of liquor and narcotic drugs are acute in this village.
